

FLINDERS ISLAND SAFE HAVEN BIOSECURITY

AIRCRAFT PRE-DEPARTURE REQUIREMENTS

1. Visiting aircraft must not have live plants, mulch, soil or live animals on board without written approval from landowners/manager
2. On the day of departure, all cabin and hold spaces, any accessible void spaces (e.g. wheel cowlings, wheel wells, etc.), and all luggage/cargo, are to be visually inspected for any stow-away:
 - i. Rodents
 - ii. Reptiles
 - iii. Amphibians
 - iv. Invertebrates
 - a. Inspections must occur on the day of intended departure – a period of darkness is not to pass between the completion of inspections and departure.
3. Should any individuals of the species listed in Clause 1 be found, they are to be wholly removed from the luggage/cargo and aircraft.
 - a. Detailed photos of any intercepted specimens are to be taken and provided to **landowners/Manager**
 - b. The discovery of any specimen is to be declared on all relevant paperwork
 - c. **Landowner/Manager** is to be contacted for suggested follow-up actions prior to departure
4. All cabin and hold spaces, any accessible void spaces (e.g. wheel cowlings, wheel wells, etc.), wheels, skids, undercarriage assemblies, and all luggage/cargo are to be inspected for any attached soil, plants, seeds or organic matter.
 - a. Any discovered soil, plants, seeds or organic matter is to be wholly removed.
 - i. The items to which that matter was attached, and those which the matter contacted, are to be treated with either: an 80% methylated spirits/water mixture, SteriGENE, Virkon S, or another approved product.
 - b. Their discovery is to be declared on all relevant paperwork
 - c. **Landowner/Manager** is to be contacted for suggested follow-up actions prior to departure
5. All cabin and hold spaces, and any accessible void spaces (e.g. wheel cowlings, wheel wells, etc.) are to be sprayed with a commercially available insect knockdown spray or fogged with a pyrethroid (bifenthrin) insecticide prior to departure for Flinders Island.

- a. Treatment must occur on the day of intended departure – a period of darkness is not to pass between the completion of treatment and departure

All goods being transported via aircraft must be inspected according to the Flinders Island Biosecurity guidelines prior to being loaded onto the aircraft.
